

Non-indigenous plant survey considerations and methods.

There are many methods by which invasive plant surveys can be conducted, and the best method depends upon the goals and objectives of the survey. This presentation, targeted toward land managers responsible for large land areas, provides an introduction to different survey methods and discusses their advantages and disadvantages. Details are then provided on methods we have found to be practical and efficient for collecting landscape level invasive plant data. Finally, new adaptive sampling methods that are being developed at Montana State University are discussed.
